## Unité 5 – Task:

#### Une vente aux enchères (An auction)

Create an **advertisement** for a house sale and write a simple dialogue that could take place at a house being auctioned.

- Create a **digital flyer** (for example using Canva or Google Docs) **or** a **drawing/poster** advertising the auction of a house in France.
- List all the **rooms** and **amenities** in the house in French.
- You should include a **photo** or a **drawing** of the house.
- Ensure that you list some of the **facilities** in the area (e.g. a school).
- You could draw a little **map** of the location of the house in relation to the town/city centre.
- Give the **price** of the house.
- Give the (real or invented) **size** of the house (e.g. 112 m<sup>2</sup>).
- Ensure that you write **complete sentences**, where possible.
- Ensure that each sentence begins with a **capital letter**.
- You may use the **headings** below as a guide as to what details you would like to give about the house.

You could present this task orally in front of your group or your class. Each of your classmates could be presented with the form without the answers and you could read out the answers for them to fill in.



Consider where you might find information to help you. In your book, online, by asking a classmate or asking the teacher.



You could also present this as a dialogue. One person could play the role of the auctioneer, who begins by outlining the details of the house and you could have two people (or several students in the class) bidding. (See vocabulary on the next page.)



You might like to do a draft of the task first and get a classmate to review what you have written before you submit the task.



If you are happy with the completed task, you might wish to save this task into your **portfolio** and/or **hang it up** in your classroom.
