



Unité 3 – Task:

Créer un dialogue dans un restaurant (Create a dialogue in a restaurant)

Write/Type/Record a dialogue in a restaurant between you and a friend. You are both looking at a menu and trying to decide on what to eat. You each express your likes, dislikes or allergies when deciding what to order.

Step 1: Create a short menu (*La carte*) in French.

Step 2: Create the dialogue.

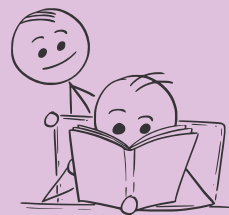
Step 3: Record (audio and/or video).

Dialogue progression

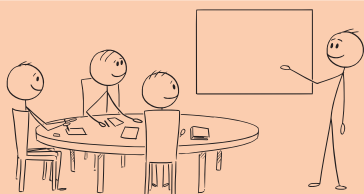
1. Opening: Start by acknowledging you are hungry and looking at the menu.
2. State preferences: Use verbs like *aimer* (to like), *adorer* (to love), or *préférer* (to prefer).
3. Mention dislikes/allergies: Use *Je n'aime pas* (I don't like) or *Je suis allergique à ...* (I am allergic to...).
4. Ask for opinion: Ask your friend what they think using *Qu'est-ce que tu penses de ...?* (What do you think of ...?).
5. Make a decision: Use the conditional *Je voudrais* (I would like) to sound polite.



To prepare for the task, you might like to search for a restaurant name and menu in French online.



You might like to do a draft of the task first and get a classmate or your teacher to review what you have written.



You could present this task orally in front of your group or your class or make a digital recording of the conversation.



If you are happy with the completed task, you might wish to save this task into your **portfolio**.
